Councilman Howell states that the city is doing the best it can do. The citizens asked if gravel could be put on Lyons Dr. Councilman Howell states that the rocks are not available to get when ever you want. Councilman Howell states that Councilman Heathcoe will check on the rocks. A citizen states that Talica is a cheap type of rock that can fix holes. Council said they will check into it. The council states that the grant money can only be used for Ducey Rd and the county will use it how they see fit on the road.
