AGENDA FOR THE CITY OF Special CREOLA COUNCIL MEETING HELD AT CREOLA CITY HALL ON May 25, 2016 @ 4:00pm

Mayor called the meeting to order and gave invocation. Pledge of Allegiance Upon the call of roll, the following were found to be present:

CITIZENS ADDRESSING THE COUNCIL

Mayor gave history of the Pay as you go program steps. Mayor encouraged citizens to talk to Commissioner Ludgood.

RESOLUTIONS, ORDINANCES OTHER BUSINESS

Mayor discussed remaining dirt roads left in Creola. Mayor asked council to decide on a list road to turn in for Pay as You Go. Mayor states it may be a good idea to put about 5 roads or more on the list.

Councilman Howell states Brown Rd should be at the top of the paving list and add Creola dr, North Bentley, Skidmore, Christy Lane and Lister Lane to be resurfaced. Councilwoman Moss states Brown Rd should be number one. Holmes Rd is going to cost a lot to move water lines.

Councilman Howell states that James Burkett should be on the list because of it leading to the cemetery. Holmes Rd is an important road as well but if the water pushes it to a costly amount, the city would be required to move the water lines and the city just does not have that kind of money but it can still be placed on the list to see what happens.

Councilman Ivy states that Brown Rd has 15 homes on it so that would make it a priority to him and Holmes Rd as well as the resurfacing of the streets.

Councilman Heathcoe states that Brown Rd should be first on the list and Holmes Rd, James Burkett.

Councilwoman Greene states Brown Rd due to amount of homes and it being one of the oldest dirt roads, and resurface Creola Dr. Councilwoman Greene states that she feels if you put to many choices on the list that Brown Rd might not get chosen again.

Councilman Heathcoe wants the citizens to know that if the city only put Brown Rd on the list and if the county does not pick it then nothing is done, it is the county's choice. The city considers all the roads important, we will always do what we can to get as much assistance as we can for the city.

Mayor asked if the council is happy with the five roads suggested, council stated they would like to place the following roads on the Pay as You Go:

- 1. Brown Rd-pave
- 2. Holmes Rd-pave
- 3. James Burkett-pave
- 4. Creola Drive-resurfacing
- 5. North Bentley-resurfacing

Adjournment

Councilman Howell made a motion to adjourn.

Councilman Ivy seconded, all favored, none opposed, motion carried.
