RESOLUTIONS ORDINANCES AND OTHER BUSINESS

The Mayor states that a bill from Gulf Equipment for the grant project had been presented for payment.

The Mayor says that he will have the payment delivered and signed for by a representative.

Councilman Moss made a motion to pay the bill for Gulf Equipment for the amount of \$122,000.00.

Councilman Heathcoe second, all favored, none opposed, motion carried.

Councilman Moss says he will be available to deliver the check to Gulf Equipment if needed.

The Mayor states that we still owe Thompson Engineering for their portion of the grant project portion of the bill which is about \$17,000. Mayor asked council to think about accepting the grant applications for the new city complex, and to let him now something by next council meeting. Councilman Heathcoe asked if the city had to have the deed for the property before the complex could be built. Mayor states that he will check with Mr. Lloyd about the deed.

Councilman Ivy states that they had agreed to purchase two radios for the price of Over \$3,000.

Councilman Ivy made a motion to purchase one radio for the price \$1623.00 and to replace the motor in car 17 with the rest of the money for the cost of \$1350.00. Councilman Moss seconded, all favored, none opposed, motion carried.

Councilman Walker asked how many miles were on car 17. Chief Taylor states that car 17 has 173,000 miles on it. Councilman Moss asked what guarantees come with the motor. Chief Taylor states that there is a 90 day warranty on the motor. Councilman Howell asked will this price buy the motor and put it in. Chief Taylor states that the motor cost \$750.00 and to put it in cost \$600.00.
