CITIZENS ADDRESSING THE COUNCIL

Mr. Kenneth Austin states he has a concern about the drainage on Creola drive, and will it be resurfaced. Mayor states that there is no place for the water to go, and the city does not have an easement for a ditch in the area. Mayor asked citizen to ask his neighbors to help get an easement to dig ditch.
