

Minutes of the City of Creola Council Meeting Thursday, February 9, 2023 Creola City Hall Meeting 6:00 P.M.

The Council of the City of Creola, Alabama, met in the Creola City Hall at 5:30 p.m. A workshop was held before the Council Meeting at 5:30 pm. Present at the meeting were Harold Parmer, Mark Howell, Cody Chambless, and Mayor Nelson. Items that were discussed were the Key to SAIL Center, Municipal Court Seminar for CEU's, Jack's teleconference, Lights for New Police 2023 Tahoe's, Fire Chief Position, Police Dept Admin Assist, Volunteer Fire Department members – incentive program, Municipal Dinner, and the Bio Recycling Facility – Radcliff Road The meeting adjourned at 6:00p.m.

The regular council meeting was called to order by Mayor Don Nelson at 6:00 p.m. We were led in prayer by Mayor Nelson. The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Mayor Nelson. Item #6- Financials/Bill List-
