RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CREOLA, ALABAMA

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE 2025 ALABAMA DIVISION A MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN, IN FULFILLMENT OF THE FEDERAL DISASTER MITIGATION ACT OF 2000 AND THE LOCAL MITIGATION PLAN REQUIREMENTS OF 44 C.F.R. SECTION 201.6 AND FEMA LOCAL MULTI-HAZARD MITIGATION PLANNING GUIDANCE

WHEREAS, the City of Creola recognizes the threat that natural hazards pose to people and property within (local community); and

WHEREAS, the City of Creola has prepared a multi-hazard mitigation plan, hereby known as the 2025 MOBILE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN in accordance with federal laws, including the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act, as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968, as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS, the 2025 MOBILE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property in the City of Creola from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS, adoption by the City of Creola demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the 2025 MOBILE COUNTY MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the 2025 Alabama Region A Multi-Hazard Mitigation Plan is hereby adopted by the Council of the City of Creola and immediately made effective.
